BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MEETING MINUTES
April 3, 2014

In Chair Helm's absence, Selectman Kidder called the meeting to order at 8:30am.

Selectman Kidder noted that the Board received a request from the 1941 Committee (a.k.a. the New London Community Center group) to withdraw their request for a warrant article for \$75,000 for the care and maintenance of the 1941 building. The group is no longer pursuing the project to convert the 1941 building for use as a community center.

IT WAS MOVED (Peter Bianchi) AND SECONDED (Janet Kidder) to remove the article for \$75,000 for the care and maintenance of the 1941 building and to cease negotiations for a lease with the Kearsarge Regional School District.

Mr. Homan asked what this meant for Town Meeting and the warrant. Ms. Hallquist noted that the Selectmen will not be placing articles on the warrant for a long-term lease of the 1941 building or to request money to support and maintain the building. However, she noted that petitions could still be submitted on this, or any other issue, to be acted on at Town Meeting (the deadline is April 8th).

A vote was called: **THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

Selectman Kidder thanked the members of the 1941 Committee for all their hard work and efforts and their leadership in trying to craft a proposal that would be suitable for the Town.
