**BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MEETING MINUTES
November 23, 2011**

Chair Kaplan called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM.

The Board reviewed the Wastewater Warrant in the amount of \$357,651.96 for collection of the second half of 2011 wastewater charges. Mr. Bianchi moved to sign the Warrant and Ms. Helm seconded the motion. All were in favor, the Board signed the Warrant.

Chair Kaplan noted that he went to Concord the previous day and testified at a legislative hearing on the issue of education funding. He joined Pat Remick, who spoke on behalf of the Coalition Communities, in urging the legislature to find acceptable language that the House, Senate and Governor will support so that the issue can go before voters to consider a constitutional amendment addressing education funding.

Mr. Bianchi informed the Board that he would like to revisit the issue discussed at the last Board meeting regarding filling the vacant fulltime highway position. He noted that while the discussion was held in public, since it came after a nonpublic session, all members of the public were gone from the meeting and thus were not able to participate in the discussion. He has asked that the matter be placed on the Board's agenda for the November 28, 2011 meeting so that members of the public will have the opportunity to comment.

Having no further business before them,

THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**
