Recreation Commission Meeting
July 2, 2015

PRESENT: Lyndsay Lund, Jason Stadler, Scott Blewitt and Janet Kidder

The Minutes of June 2, 2015 were approved.

The Strawberry Festival realized a profit of \$1350.00. There was a motion to add this money to the van fund, for a total of \$16,500.00. The motion was approved.

Scott noted that the food that was not consumed at the Strawberry Festival (extra strawberries, hot dogs, etc.) was eaten by the campers.

The Day Camp attendance has doubled from last year (50 plus campers per week). Danielle Jollah is camp director.

Ron O'Keefe, representative of Health Trust (the Town's insurance company) visited both beaches and conducted life guard training. He did not have any recommendations for Scott other than having signage at both beaches. The signs were in the process of being made, and should be installed shortly. Scott further noted that the Sunapee Rescue Squad conducted another safety training for New London beach staff at Dewey Beach. EMT's assisted with the training.

There are two new docks at Bucklin Beach, new windows were installed at the Elkins' bath house, and a new plastic dock was moored at Elkins.

Lyndsay suggested that a camera system with locks that could be accessed via an app be installed instead of locks that could be damaged. The added benefit would be that the bathrooms could be left open until 9:00 pm. Scott will check with Kim about utilizing that system.

Scott reported that 38 runners participated in the Granite State Track Meet. Mary Ann Morcom is the coach.

Scott would like to have a rack built for equipment.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:06 pm. The next meeting is Tuesday, August 4th at 5:00 pm.
