**BOARD OF SELECTMEN
NONPUBLIC MEETING MINUTES**

March 18, 2013

The Board met in nonpublic session pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II(a). Ms. Hallquist informed the Board that she has been made aware of a criminal investigation being conducted by the Attorney General's Office concerning Police Chief David Seastrand. Investigators from the AG's Office will be conducting interviews of selected town employees in the coming weeks. Personnel from the AG's Office have stated that they are unable to share details of the investigation at this time. As a result, in the opinion of Ms. Hallquist, there is no further action needed by the Board at this time. Ms. Hallquist will keep the Board apprised of the situation as necessary.

IT WAS MOVED (Tina Helm) AND SECONDED (Janet Kidder) to seal the nonpublic session minutes pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, III: divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of the public body itself. A vote on the motion to seal was taken: 3 – 0 to seal the Minutes.

IT WAS MOVED (Janet Kidder) AND SECONDED (Tina Helm) to move out of nonpublic session. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.
