

TOWN OF NEW LONDON
PARKING ORDINANCES
Adopted September 21, 2009
Amended May 2, 2011

Following a public hearing on May 2, 2011, and pursuant to NH RSAs 31:39, 41:11, 41:11-a, 47:17 VII, VIII and XVII, and 265:71, the Board of Selectmen hereby adopt the following ordinances related to parking in the Town of New London.

SECTION # 1 PARKING ORDINANCES

There shall be NO PARKING at any time in designated areas when signs are erected giving notice thereof.

1-1 No Parking

The following areas listed are NO PARKING AT ANY TIME zones within the Town of New London.

Camp Sunapee Road -- both sides of the road

- From Little Sunapee Road (Route 114) to 300' west of Little Sunapee Road (Route 114)

County Road -- both sides of the road

- 100' north of the last entrance of Jake's Market (car wash) to 100' south of the last entrance of the New London Shopping Center
- Burpee Hill/Knights Hill Road intersection to Fieldstone Lane

Davis Hill Road -- both sides of the road

- 400' from Route 103A and 400' from Route 11

Elkins Road -- east side of the road

- Bunker Road to Wilmot Center Road

Elkins Road -- west side of the road

- The Point Cottages to 100' beyond the Elkins Road intersection onto Wilmot Center Road

Gould Road -- both sides of the road

- From Seamans Road to Pleasant Street

Little Sunapee Road (Route 114) -- both sides of the road

- Camp Sunapee Road to Twin Lake Villa Road

Main Street (Route 114) -- north side of road

- Intersection of Quail Run to # 675
- In the area of #260 Main Street
- Pressey Court to intersection of Little Sunapee Road

Main Street (Route 114) -- south side of road

- 60' in front of #394 Main Street (OMB/Aesthetics/Pizza Chef building)
- 60' in front of #384 Main Street (New London Minimart/Subway)
- Intersection of South Pleasant Street to Municipal parking lot

- 60' east of Hayes Road to 40' east of Pearl Street
- Intersection of Williams Street to Hayes Road (except as allowed in Sections 1-3 and 1-8, below).

Newport Road -- both sides of road

- From Main Street/Little Sunapee Road (Route 114) entrance to Hilltop Place driveway

Newport Road -- south side of road

- Fenwood Drive to Main Street (Route 114)

Old Dump Road -- both sides of the road

- Beginning 300' from intersection with Little Sunapee Road (Route 114)

Otterville Road -- east side of the road

- Intersection of Route 11 to Goose Hole Road

Otterville Road -- west side of the road

- Driveway of #591 Otterville Road to intersection of Goose Hole Road

Route 11 (Newport Road) -- both sides of the road

- 300' east of the Otterville Road intersection to the Sunapee Town line

Route 103A -- both sides of the road

- From Route 11 to Herrick Cove Lane

Seamans Road -- east side of the road

- Main Street (Route 114) to Sargent Road (Route 11)

Seamans Road -- west side of the road

- Town Hall Driveway to Main Street (Route 114)
- 100' south of the Kelsey Fields entrance to 100' north of the Kelsey Fields entrance

South Pleasant Street -- both sides of the road

- Main Street (Route 114) to Barrett Road

1-2 No Parking Here to Corner

The following areas listed are NO PARKING HERE TO CORNER within the Town of New London.

Main Street (Route 114) and;

- Williams Street
- Parkside Road
- Cougar Court
- Lovering Lane
- South Pleasant Street
- Seamans Road
- Squires Lane
- 596 Main Street

1-3 No Parking Limited by Time

The following areas listed are parking spaces limited by time within the Town of New London.

Main Street (Route 114) from Route 11 (Andover Road) to Newport Road	No overnight parking
Seamans Road from Gould Road to Police Department (27 Seamans Road)	Three hour parking
Main Street (Route 114) in front of the New London Barn Playhouse	Five minute parking

1-4 No Parking (Seasonal)

The following areas listed are NO PARKING AT ANY TIME DURING THE SEASONAL PERIOD described within the Town of New London.

- No parking on **ALL** town streets or parking lots between the hours of 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM from November 1 to April 1 of each year.
- No parking during a declared snow emergency on the south side of Main Street (Route 114) designated by the New London Highway Department and/or the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation for the duration of the emergency.
- No parking on Williams Street from May 31 to September 30 each year.
- No parking for longer than twenty (20) minutes between the hours of 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM within the Whipple Memorial Town Hall parking lot and the parking spaces on Seamans Road between Gould Road and Main Street during the following Elections held at Whipple Memorial Town Hall:
 - New Hampshire Primary Day
 - Town Meeting (second Tuesday in May)
 - September State Primary Day
 - November Election (first Tuesday in November)

1-5 No Parking Stopping or Standing

The following areas listed are NO PARKING STOPPING OR STANDING at any time within the Town of New London.

- County Road -- both sides of the road
 - 100' north of the last entrance of Jake's Market (car wash) to 100' south of the last entrance of the New London Shopping Center
- All dry hydrants and fire cisterns on any public or private road or way.

1-6 No Parking per order of the Chief of Police

There shall be NO PARKING at any time in designated areas when signs are erected giving notice thereof. The Police Chief or his/her designee shall have the authority to restrict or prohibit parking on any Town street or parking lot whenever the use of same becomes hazardous to do so, or if an emergency condition exist that requires same.

1-7 No Parking (Permit Parking only)

The following areas listed are limited to parking with an official and current Town of New London permit that was issued by the Town of New London for that specific vehicle, period of time, or person or business that is entitled to park at this restricted area. The following areas listed are PERMIT ONLY PARKING areas with in the Town of New London.

- Bucklin Beach parking lot, located off of Camp Sunapee Road.
- Old Dump Road, both sides of the road from the intersection with Little Sunapee Road (Route 114) until No Parking Zone at 300'
- Elkins Beach parking lot, located off of Elkins Road.

1-8 No Parking (Handicapped parking)

The New London Police Department shall have the authority to issue a summons when someone not entitled to do so, parks in a space on private or public property that is reserved for persons who are disabled, so long as the parking space is marked by a sign affixed to a post or on a building clearly visible to anyone directly approaching that space.

1-9 No Parking (Facing the Wrong Way)

Pursuant to RSA 265:61, all parked vehicles within the Town of New London upon a roadway where there are adjacent curbs shall be parked with the right-hand wheels of said vehicle parallel to the right-hand curb, or if upon a roadway without curbs, said vehicle shall be parked with the right-hand wheels parallel to the right-hand side of the traveled portion.

1-10 No Parking (Official Vehicles Official business only)

The Town of New London Police Department located at the Whipple Memorial Town Hall and the New London Fire Department located at 237 Main Street have members of each respective organization that require them in the performance of their duties to gain access to and respond from those facilities without delay or restriction. Therefore spaces adjacent to these facilities shall be restricted to and available for those members only.

SECTION # 2 PENALTIES AND FINES

2-1 Penalties and Fines.

All parking violations shall be \$25.00 except as provided in the following paragraphs:

- A. Handicapped Zone: The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be \$50.00.
- B. Summons: Any summons submitted to the court of jurisdiction will have a penalty of not less than \$250.00.

2-2 Owner Responsibility for Illegal Parking

A person shall not allow or permit a vehicle registered in his name to stand or park in violation of any of the ordinances of the Town of New London controlling the standing or parking of vehicles and the owner or person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be held a prima facie responsible for such violation.

2-3 Notice of Violation

A police officer observing a violation of any of the provisions of these Parking Ordinances shall attach to the vehicle a notice to the operator or owner that the vehicle has been parked in violation and instructing the operator or owner to report to police headquarters. The notice shall contain:

- A Location: The location where the vehicle is parked.
- B Registration number of vehicle: The state registration number of the vehicle.
- C Time of Violation: The time at which such vehicle is parked in violation of any of the provisions of these ordinances.
- D Any Other Facts: Any other facts, knowledge of which is necessary to a thorough understand of the circumstances attending such violation.

2-4 Procedure for Paying Penalties


The operator or owner may pay the fine within ten (10) working days of the time when a notice was attached to the vehicle that a violation of the Parking Ordinances has occurred. The fine is paid to the Town of New London through the New London Police Department as a penalty and in lieu of court proceedings. Failure by the operator or owner to make such payment within 10 working days may result in the issuance of a summons to the operator or owner to appear in court to answer to charges of violation of the ordinance. The Chief of Police may authorize, at any time before a court summons has been issued, but not after the expiration of the ten (10) working day period, the acceptance of a voluntary payment as a penalty in full satisfaction of the violation.

2-5 Towing Vehicles Away

The New London Police Department is authorized to remove and tow away or have removed and towed away by a commercial towing service, any abandoned vehicle or other vehicle illegally parked in a place where it creates or constitutes a traffic hazard, blocks use of a fire hydrant, or obstructs or may obstruct snow removal operations or the movement of any emergency vehicle. Vehicles towed for illegal parking shall be stored in a safe place and shall be returned to the owner or operator upon payment of all fees for towing and storage.

After public hearing, the above ordinance was adopted, as amended, by the Board of Selectmen on May 2, 2011.


