A public hearing is scheduled for the following application(s) or requests:

**New London Wood Products Site Plan.** Located at 1554 King Hill Road. Tax Map 129-015-000. Property owned by Dean and Pamela Larpenner. Proposal is to build a 30 x 34 square foot horse barn for two-horses. Activities currently conducted on the site include a sawmill operation, manufacturing of grade stakes and selling of kiln dried firewood. Zoned ARR. Waivers requested. **Public Hearing continued from the September 23rd meeting.**

**Colby- Sawyer College Site Plan Application for Improvements to Colgate Hall.** Located at 541 Main Street. Tax Map 085-033-000. Improvements to relocate the lower level nursing lab to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, update the lower level space to become ADA compliant and divide one classroom into two classrooms. Zoned Institutional. Waivers requested.

If the Planning Board deems the site plan and subdivision applications complete, they will open the public hearing to receive testimony from abutters and other parties as defined in RSA 672:3.
