


BACKGROUND:

I started to bake since I was a little girl but my life turned me around Universities and several degrees before I realized what always was my real vocation after my second pregnancy when I decided to change my lifestyle and work just on what I really loved and bring me peace and happiness.

After several little courses and a few years working as amateur baker and working on my own in Belgium; I decided to give the big step and went to study real French high-end and professional pastry and where else than in Paris, what better than the self Ritz with most of the best and sophisticated Pastry Chefs in the world and finish my training with the Ritz Tea Sommelier on Ritz – Paris Tea Service Style.



I decided to work from home just because I do not want to lose the track of my children's lives, I do not want to see them grow while they are sleeping, I want to be able to be there and teach them what I do. I want to be able to make them decent food and attend them and be with them when they need me and



those things are almost impossible when you are working out of your house, so you just can't run and leave everything behind unattended, or just ask everybody to leave because you have to close suddenly.

For this reason, I also want something small, cozy and cottage style like the bakeries, pastries, and B&B (bed and breakfast) in the little mountain villages in Europe. That way I can manage it on my own and won't need more help than maybe one or two people from time to time but not too cook.

THE IDEA: (High-End Bakery-Pastry Shop / Cater / Tea Service / School)

My idea/dream in a place like this is to have a cottage business, help to promote the local culture through a small pastry shop and salon de thé (tea room), where I can sell anything related with tea time: sweet and savory products, French press coffee, European style hot chocolate, French (imported from France) teas, sparkling water, plain water, orange juice, beer, wine. Also a small bakery and pastry shop: European style bread, viennoiserie, tarts (pies), all kind of cakes, mignardises (mini pastries)... Offer some baking lessons from time to time and of course cater (small amount because I am a solo baker) to events, tea service, restaurants, hotels, bakeries and participate in fairs, events, markets...

WHERE:

We bought this beautiful place (246 King Hill RD, New London NH), it is a log cabin in the middle of 6.7 acres of forest (Agricultural / Residential). This log cabin has 3 stories where the very first one is not being used and there is just a small room where all the machinery of the house is: heater, water purificator, pump, laundry, and dryer machines... The rest of this very first story has not another use then maybe another living room (which upstairs there are already 2) and maybe a guest room with a bathroom. This very first story has independent entry leveled with a low level of the ground.



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The second story, leveled with the highest point of the ground has the kitchen, a family room, a dining room, a living room, a balcony, and a toilet. Then the third and last one has three bedrooms and bathrooms.




So in the very first story there is room enough to place my pastry/bakery kitchen, it has already a toilet and a small and cozy porche which is right now half enclosed but will replace what is right now and will be fully enclosed to place some tables and chairs, from there the clients will have a beautiful, cozy and peaceful view of the forest and the small flower pots.

We also want to plant some pumpkins, rhubarb, wheat, corn, flowers, etc. And place in the center a small enclosed gazebo to offer private tea parties.

Also in 6.7 acres of land, I have room enough to place a small parking spot for maybe 4 - 6 cars, apart of our garages. This house is located over the Route 11, so won't bother neighbors around, and is already a high traffic road and has its own and private driveway.

We also have a Pick Up (truck) with its own Snow Plow, so we can be sure that we can keep cleaning the driveway properly.

Would love to have fully opened the schedule to be able to open all the week (Monday to Friday) from 8am to 4pm. And from time to time a small brunch on Sundays from 9am to 12m. g


LOCUS MAP





TYPICAL LEACH FIELD CROSS SECTION


