



Protection Map 2001





WATERBODY/WETLAND: Unnamed Wetland

Based upon review of the above referenced application, in accordance with RSA 482-A and RSA 485-A:17, a Wetlands Permit and Non-Site Specific Permit was issued. This permit shall not be considered valid unless signed as specified below.

PERMIT DESCRIPTION: Dredge 400 sq.ft. of emergent marsh to 8 foot depth to deepen the water source to install a dry hydrant and clean the outlet of an existing roadway culvert, work shall be conducted in accordance with plans received on 10/16/97.

THIS APPROVAL IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROJECT SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

1. Additional expedited minimum impact applications shall be accepted for the subject property for a period of 12 months only if the applicant demonstrates by plan that the additional project(s) are wholly unrelated or separate from the original application and when considered with the original application are not classified as minor or major.
2. Work authorized shall be carried out such that discharges in spawning or nursery areas during spawning seasons shall be avoided, and impacts to such areas shall be avoided or minimized to the maximum extent practicable during all times of the year.
3. Work shall be carried out in a time and manner such that disturbance to migratory waterfowl breeding areas and spawning areas shall be avoided.
4. No fill shall be done for lot development.
5. Appropriate siltation/erosion/turbidity controls shall be in place prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction, and shall remain until the area is stabilized.
6. Within three days of the last activity in an area, all exposed soil areas, where construction activities are complete or have been temporarily suspended, shall be stabilized by seeding and mulching during the growing season, or if not within the growing season, by mulching with tack or netting and pinning on slopes steeper than 3:1.
7. Dredged material shall be placed out of the DES Wetlands Bureau jurisdiction.
8. Work shall be done during low flow.

GENERAL CONDITIONS WHICH APPLY TO ALL DES WETLANDS PERMITS:

1. This permit shall be posted on site during construction in a secured manner in a prominent location visible to inspecting personnel;
2. This permit does not convey a property right, nor authorize any injury to property of others, nor invasion of rights of others;
3. The Wetlands Bureau shall be notified upon completion of work;
4. This permit does not relieve the applicant from the obligation to obtain other local, state or federal permits that may be required;
5. This permit shall not be transferred to a new owner or extended beyond the current expiration date without further approval by the Department.
