- 1. Call to Order: Chair Gorman called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.**
- 2. Organizational Overview & Review of Process:**

Chair Gorman provided an overview of the previous CIP and the projects that were included in the plan. The group discussed the two projects with pending study results, the Buker Annex and the Transfer Station, and decided to proceed with the CIP process and amend as information from the studies became available.

Chair Gorman suggested that the committee begin to meet with department heads at the next CIP meeting, starting with the Fire Department, Police Department and the Public Works Department. Each department will be allotted 20 minutes to provide a summary of the projects they would like to be considered for the CIP.

It was suggested that we include the Chair of the Energy Committee in the CIP process to discuss how the Town can utilize its facilities to produce energy, such as solar on the roof of the DPW building.

Liz Meller shared that she attended a meeting recently where the Exit 12 Park & Ride was discussed. She said that Rep. Karen Ebel said she would pursue expansion of the Park & Ride at the State level.

The group discussed the traffic concerns along the Main Street and Newport Road corridors. It was suggested to consider the concerns as safety concerns versus traffic concerns and to consider what improvements can be implemented through the CIP.

Joe Cardillo suggested that the CIP Committee should meet either the Budget Committee or the Finance Committee to learn more about the bonding schedule and when different bonds are scheduled to be retired. The Committee agreed that meeting with the Finance Manager would be beneficial to the CIP process.
