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## BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES April 14, 2014

Chair Helm opened the meeting at 8:00AM.

The Board reviewed the draft Warrant for the 2014 Town Meeting. Elections will be held on Tuesday, May 13<sup>th</sup> and the Town Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. It was noted that a change was needed to Article 12 to reflect the correct reference to the Elkins Sidewalk Project Article.

**IT WAS MOVED (Peter Bianchi) AND SECONDED (Janet Kidder) to approve the warrant for the 2014 Town Meeting. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.**

Chair Helm questioned the progress of setting up a meeting with the governing boards of the towns New London dispatches for (Croydon, Sunapee, Newbury, Grantham, Wilmot, and Sutton). Ms. Hallquist noted that only a few of the towns have responded to date with interest in meeting with the New London Board of Selectmen. The meeting will be arranged after elections in May, so that the new selectperson can participate.

Selectman Kidder followed up on an earlier question on two Recreation Department expenses by reporting that the repair of the recreation van and the recreation department's share of the cost of the speaker system will come out of the Recreation Revolving fund.

The Board reviewed requests for permits. Selectman Bianchi suggested that the after-the-fact building permit for Stuart & Victoria Gulker should not be released until a visual inspection is made by the Planning & Zoning Administrator to confirm that the work in the building permit had been done as permitted. The Board agreed that its approval of the permit was contingent on the visual inspection and confirmation that the work had been done as described in the permit application.
