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BOARD OF SELECTMEN APPROVED MEETING MINUTES May 14, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm.

Property Tax Warrant

The Board reviewed the warrant for the collection of the first and second billing of 2015 property taxes, in the amount of \$8,619,493.40. The first bill is due July 1, 2015 and the second bill is due October 1, 2015.

IT WAS MOVED (Nancy Rollins) AND SECONDED (Peter Bianchi) to approve the warrant as presented. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.

Sandra Rowse – Building Permit

The Board reviewed a building permit application as submitted by Sandra Rowse, (122-002-000) 18 Sutton Road. The permit will add fire safety measures and make interior renovations to the two residential dwelling units. The Board noted receipt of a letter from abutters Steven & Philomena Landrigan that expressed concerns over the use of the Rowse property. Finding the building permit to be complete and consistent with the zoning ordinance, the permit was approved as requested.

IT WAS MOVED (Nancy Rollins) AND SECONDED (Peter Bianchi) to approve the building permit as requested by Sandra Rowse, 18 Sutton Road. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.

Academy Building – Frank Anzalone Associates Agreement

The Board reviewed the revised agreement as submitted by Frank Anzalone Associates for work associated with the Academy Building repair project. Selectman Bianchi noted his concern that the inspection and oversight contemplated in the agreement is not as extensive as he had anticipated, however he would go along with Mr. Anzalone's recommendation as to the proper amount of time needed in this phase of the project.

IT WAS MOVED (Nancy Rollins) AND SECONDED (Peter Bianchi) to approve the agreements dated May 8, 2015 as proposed by Frank Anzalone Associates. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.
