Public Hearing Notice – SCENIC ROADS

New London Planning Board

Tuesday, February 12, 2013

The New London Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing per the request of Public Service of New Hampshire (PSNH) pursuant to **RSA 231:158 Scenic Roads** for the trimming and removal of trees. Work on those roads not designated as scenic is scheduled to begin in late January.

The Town Master Plan identifies the following scenic roads: Camp Sunapee Road, County Road (Knight Hill Road to Tracy Road), Pingree Road, Soo Nipi Park Road, Davis Hill Road, Whitney Brook Road and Forty Acres Road. Shaker Street was adopted as a scenic road in May 2012. Tree cutting provisions and natural resources protection provisions are included in several sections of the Town Zoning Ordinance including Article XIII, Wetlands Conservation Overlay District; Article XVI- Shoreland Overlay District; Article XXII- Streams Conservation Overlay District and Article XIV- Steep Slope Overlay District.

PSNH specifications call for removal of brush and limbs less than four inches in diameter which are located within eight feet to the side of, ten feet below or fifteen feet above conductors. Larger trees or limbs which present a threat to PSNH lines or other equipment because of decay or other defect will be removed on a case by case basis. PSNH has contracted with Asplundh Tree Expert Company to perform the actual trimming of trees. PSNH requires that their trimming contractors contact each landowner where trees are to be trimmed prior to commencement of work on that property.

All Town of New London public meetings are accessible for persons with disabilities. The Town Office is handicapped accessible.
