The NH Floodplain Management Program will be offering the *Managing Floodplain Development Through the NFIP* course this fall! It will be held **September 28—October 2, 2015** at the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services Regional Office at Pease International Tradeport, Portsmouth NH.

This course is designed to provide a training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinance. The course will focus on the NFIP and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. Participants that are Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM) are also eligible to receive **12 CECs** for attending this 4-day course. A CFM exam will be held on the last day of the course. Description

This is the field deployed version of the FEMA Emergency Management Institute (EMI) E273 course. This course is designed to provide an organized training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinance. The course will focus on the NFIP and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance.

Selection Criteria: Local officials responsible for administering local floodplain management ordinances, including but not limited to floodplain management administrators, building inspectors, code enforcement/zoning officers, planners, city/county managers, attorneys, engineers, and public works officials. Federal/State/regional floodplain managers also are encouraged to attend. The course is designed for those officials with less than 3 years of floodplain management experience.

Prerequisites:


Prior to the course, participants must complete the:

- FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) tutorial (30 min).
- FEMA Federal Insurance Studies (FIS) tutorial (40 min).
