Dear Applicants:

Based upon a recent request, we are hereby amending RSA 485-A:17 Alteration of Terrain Permit AoT 1072A. **The amendment consists of the addition of permittees owning Lots 6, 7, 10 and 11 and plan changes including relocation of the private road and restoration of the existing road on those lots.** The amended permit number is AoT-1072A and is subject to the following conditions:

1. Activities shall not cause or contribute to any violations of the surface water quality standards established in Administrative Rule Env-Wq 1700.
2. You must submit revised plans for permit amendment prior to any changes in construction details or sequences. You must notify the Department in writing within ten days of a change in ownership.
3. You must notify the Department in writing prior to the start of construction and upon completion of construction. Forms are available at: <http://des.nh.gov/organization/divisions/water/aot/categories/forms.htm>.
4. The plans, dated February (received April 21, 2016) and January 12, 2017 (with revisions dated February 9, 2017) and supporting documentation in the permit file are a part of this approval.
5. All stormwater practices shall be inspected and maintained in accordance with Env-Wq 1507.08 and the project Inspection and Maintenance (I&M) Manual. All record keeping required by the I&M Manual shall be maintained by the identified responsible party, and be made available to the department upon request.
6. **This permit expires on April 21, 2021.** No earth moving activities shall occur on the project after this expiration date unless the permit has been extended by the Department. If an extension is required, the request must be received by the department before the permit expires. 7. This permit does not relieve the applicant from the obligation to obtain other local, state or federal permits that may be required (e.g., from US EPA, US Army Corps of Engineers, etc.). Projects disturbing over 1 acre may require a



8. If applicable, no activity shall occur in wetland areas until a Wetlands Permit is obtained from the Department. Issuance of this permit does not obligate the Department to approve a Wetlands Permit for this project.
