ATTENTION TOWN OF NEW LONDON RESIDENTS & VISITORS WINTER PLOWING AND PARKING ORDINANCES

The Town of New London would like you to be aware of the following state and local winter regulations on parking and snow removal:

1. Per RSA 236:20 and New London Ordinance adopted March 22, 1993, it is a violation to deposit snow or ice upon a traveled roadway or public sidewalk that would cause it to be unsuitable for travel by person, vehicle, or snow plow. The penalty for such a violation is \$25.
2. Per RSA 236:21, any person who places snow, ice or other debris which covers a fire hydrant so as to make it inaccessible for immediate use in the event of a fire, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Please notify your landscaping and snow removal personnel to avoid placing snow, ice or other debris on or around fire hydrants near your property.
3. Per New London Ordinance adopted November 8, 1999, it is a violation to park a motor vehicle on any street or way or in any public parking lot within the Town of New London between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., from November 1 to April 1. Furthermore, it is a violation to park on Main Street from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., at any time of the year. The penalty for such a violation is \$25.
4. Per New London Ordinance adopted November 8, 1999, during a declared snow emergency, it is a violation to park a motor vehicle on the side of Main Street designated by the New London Highway Department and the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation with signage indicating temporary no parking for the duration of the emergency. During an emergency, the State DOT will post signs and orange flags prohibiting parking on the south side of Main Street. The penalty for such a violation is \$25.
