NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE TO KEEP OUR LITTLE PUMPKINS SAFE

- *Main St will be closed from Main St and Seaman's Rd to Main St and Newport Rd starting at 4pm till 8pm.
- ***NO THRU TRAFFIC on Main St.** Traffic to businesses will be allowed but any traffic on Main St will be directed to the closest street to get off of Main St.
- *All intersecting streets to Main St will be closed to vehicles trying to get onto Main St.
- *Traffic coming into New London from the **South**, will be directed up Gould Rd to Cougar Ct then across Main St onto Parkside Rd. From there traffic will have the option to go north or south on Barrett Rd or Everett Park or continue on Parkside Rd.
- *Traffic coming into New London from the **North**, will be directed off of Newport Rd at Everett Park and will have to travel south on Everett Park to Barrett Rd and then onto Squires Ln where they will reach Main St.
