RE: Wetland delineation on New London's transfer station lot

Dear Mr. Nadeau:

The purpose of this letter is to certify that Beaver Tracks, LLC has completed wetland delineations at the above-referenced parcel. The wetland delineations were completed on January 2, 2019 by Jonathan Sisson (CWS #235). There were two wetlands flagged. The wetlands were flagged with fluorescent blue flagging. Wetlands A and B are Palustrine Forested wetlands (PFO1C). Below are listed the flag numbers used for the two wetlands and any connections between flags.

Wetland #	Flag Numbers	Connections
A	A1 to A20	None
B	B1 to B8	None

Approximate flag locations are shown on the attached sheet of paper. The exact location of the wetland flags will have to be located using appropriate surveying techniques.

Wetlands are determined according to *Regional Supplement to the Corps of Engineers Wetland Delineation Manual: Northcentral and Northeast Region*, Version 2.0 ERDC/EL TR-12-1, January 2012 to the 1987 Corps of Engineers Wetland Delineation Manual, Technical Report Y-87-1. Wetlands are classified in accordance with the procedures outlined in the USFWS "Methodology for the Classification of Wetlands and Deepwater Habitats", 1987. The plants are classified using the 2014 US Army Corps of Engineers Northcentral and Northeast Wetland Plant List v3.2 The soils are evaluated in accordance with the *Field Indicators of Hydric Soils in the United States A Guide for Identifying and Delineating Hydric Soils, Version 8.1, 2017*.
