We are writing to express our full support of David and Anne Wustrow's application for the removal of a tree within the 50 foot setback on their property at 575 Forest Acres Road to facilitate the renovation of their current home.

We live at 533 Forest Acres Road. The Wustrows have been our neighbors for over 10 years and our properties abut. For the time we have known them, the Wustrows have shown themselves to be conscientious stewards of the Messer Pond watershed. They have always maintained appropriate and viable erosion buffers between their cottage and pond.

In addition, The Wustrow's are active members on the Messer Pond Protective Association (MPPA). The goal of the MPPA is to maintain the health of the pond and its watershed. To that end, Dave and Anne have volunteered their time in support of those objectives.
